




Glyn Hopkins Memorial Scholarship Program

The Scholarship

Under the auspices of the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology, the college will award up to three (3) General Scholarships towards the BMET Certificate or HISM Certificate program, as well as one (1) scholarship designated for either BMET or HISM associate degree programs.

All scholarship applicants must submit applications through the Student Services Department. Guidelines & Eligibility

BMET and HISM Certificate General Scholarships

Students must be entering their academic year of college to qualify for the certificate program general scholarship. In addition, a student must be pursuing an academic program offered by the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology, either the Biomedical Equipment Technician (BMET) or Healthcare Information Systems Management (HISM) program:

- BMET Certificate Program offered at the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology Students must be pursuing an academic and career path associated with the HTM career field.
- HISM Certificate Program offered at the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology
 St Students must be pursuing an academic and career path associated with the HTM career field.

BMET and HISM associate degree General Scholarships

The Scholarship for students who have completed the BMET (24 Credit) or HISM (30 Credit) certificate programs and wish to continue their education in pursuit of either the BMET or HISM AAS degree may apply for the associate degree General Scholarship.

BMET A.A.S. degree offered at the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology
 Students must have successfully completed the BMET Certificate Program at the college of biomedical equipment technology (CBET).

u HISM A.A.S. degree offered at the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology

Students must have successfully completed the BMET Certificate Program at the college of biomedical equipment technology (CBET).

Applications must be complete to be considered by the scholarship selection committee. Each portion of the application will be examined and considered. Evaluators will evaluate and consider each section separately. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Evaluation Standards

- Prior Academic Success: Transcript and academic records evaluation
- Essay Requirements: Essays must be typed. Points may be lost for poor grammar, incorrect spelling, or lack of neatness. Proofread carefully.
- **Professional/Work History and Experience:** Work experience will be limited to the *last three years* prior to the date of the application. List your most recent work experience first and include any jobs held during high school if within the three-year period. Indicate the year in school during which you held a particular position. Indicate if your work experience was in the form of work-study, co-op, or practicum. Clearly identify the nature of the business of the listed employers; in particular, note any experience related to the healthcare industry. Be complete and accurate. List additional experience on a separate sheet and attach if necessary.
- **Recommendations:** A recommendation is needed from someone other than a family member or close friend. Use the attached form—a letter is not sufficient. Letters sent in addition to forms will be read and are appreciated. Greater weight will be given for a recommendation from a person with professional experience in the healthcare technology management industry. The Evaluators contact information must be included in the scholarship application.
- Extracurricular and Volunteer Activities: List all extracurricular and volunteer activities under the indicated categories and years. Include offices held and other leadership roles in any organizations. Be as complete as possible. If there are no activities, write "none". The more activities you list, the higher your potential score.

Application Checklist

Provide a copy of your high school or college transcript (official)
Provide a copy of your resume and a short bio (50-100 words) describing yourself
Provide a Photocopy of your official government identification (Driver's license or passport)
Provide a minimum of two letters of recommendation (preferably from a representative in healthcare)
Provide an essay (300 Words) describing your interest in working in the HTM industry
Complete and Sign the Scholarship Application
Complete and Sign an Enrollment Application for the College of Biomedical Equipment Technology
